Requirements:-

- 1) Minimum of 7 years judging experience in the breed and have the support of five (5) Breed Clubs.
- 2) To have judged at 2 full or 4 half breed club shows (inclusive of Limited Breed Club Shows)
- 3) To have judged the breed at 10 Open or Ch. Shows without CC's with an adequate geographical spread.
- 4) To have judged a minimum of 65 classes.
- 5) To have judged a minimum of 80 dogs in this breed. (as per K.C. 3rd July 2014)
- 6) To have attended a seminar given by a Kennel Club Accredited Trainer, and passed the relevant examination on Kennel Club Regulations and Judging Procedures. (K.C. POLICY AS OF 1.7.2001)
- 7) (A) To have attended a seminar given by a Kennel Club Accredited Trainer on Conformation and Movement. (K.C. POLICY AS OF 1.7.2001)
(B) To have attended a Conformation & Movement " Hands on Assessment " (50 points of a dog) conducted by a Kennel Club Accredited Trainer and passed the assessment K.C. Policy as of 1.7.2005)
- 8) To have attended at least one Chow seminar run in accordance with the relevant Kennel Club Code of Best Practice and passed an examination and / or assessment where applicable. (K.C. POLICY AS OF 1.7.2001)
- 9) To have bred and / or owned a minimum of 3 dogs when they obtained their 1st entry in the Kennel Club Stud Book (except in exceptional circumstances)
- 10) To have stewarded at 12 Shows (K.C. Policy)

- 3) To have judged the breed at 10 Open or Ch. Shows without CC's with an adequate geographical spread.
- 4) To have judged a minimum of 65 classes.
- 5) To have judged a minimum of 80 dogs in this breed (as per K.C.3rd July 2014)
- 6) To have awarded CC's in at least ONE other breed.
- 7) To have attended at least one Chow judging seminar run in accordance with the relevant Kennel Club Code of Best Practice and passed an examination on the breed.
- 8) To have bred and / or owned a minimum of 3 dogs of any breed when they obtained their 1st entry in the Kennel Club Stud Book (except in exceptional circumstances)
